REVIEW MEETING: HIGHLIGHTS & HINDERANCES
HSCsthrough CSO facilitation by UPJN Units of 20 AMRUT ULBs
Date: June 19th 2019 Venue: Directorate of ULBs, Gomti Nagar Extension, Lucknow

- 01. A meeting to review HSCs in 20 ULBs under AMRUT Mission-UP was held at the Directorate of Local Bodies under the Chairmanship of the Director ULBs, Dr. Kajal, and attended by the implementing agency; concerned Units of UP Jal Nigam represented by their respective Project Managers & Executive Engineers. The meeting commenced with a brief self-introduction. (Attendance Sheet appended at Annexure A).
- 02. The Chair set the tone to take the agenda forward: the State's concerns, importance and urgency pertaining to the subject were clearly laid out, and she further underlined the participation and role of CSOs'interfacing with the citizens while facilitating the HSCs process.
- 03. All the concerned officials were directed to push the momentum of the work to providehigh quality and HSCs complete with all its components so as the STPs can function efficiently and in full capacity. She also mentioned that the Government is ready to provide all the necessary aids required to run the programmeeffectively.
- 04. The SSU made a Presentation on a Model Case developed in **ShaikhpurKasaila** locality under Lucknow District-3 Part 2. The following points were shared with to showcase pre-&-post images of the attended locality in the Model Mode, along with implementation timelines.
 - Issues that existed in the area before the engagement of (1) UP Jal Nigam, (2) CSOs, and (3)
 JalkalVibhag Lucknow Nagar Nigam were identified; agreed on the perspectives of the shared roadmap.
 - Effects of the joint efforts were well-coordinated and initiated by all the three Agencies resulted into a considerable change at the ground-level. The improvements were visible that too in a short period of time. It helped in changing the community response into a lot positive, and accordingly there surged an obvious support-response from them. Such images, which were evidentialto this effect, shared through this PPT. It also explained the chronology of the initiatives, and the results thereof.
 - Evidences of the three different stages of the built-up of the case through the on-site images, and that of thecommunities' perspectives with respect to on-groundchange-processwere shared too.
 - Finally, an insight overview of how such efforts can be carried out in other areas to get better results was suggested.

2. The following issues were brought to the notice by the participants. The Advisor Programmes Implementation Support - SMCG & Nodal Officer for HSCs was assigned to facilitate the follow-up by the Directorate. The issues highlighted in brief are as the following _

01	Ayodhya	Requirement of funds for the maintenance of STP.			
02	Azamgarh	20.74 kms of sewer pipeline yet to be laid. Of the total estimated of 6,667 HSCs, 2,780 stand complete. One STP of 8 MLD capacity is proposed; requires land for STP.			
03	Ballia Sewer line is choked in different places, Total 7,171 HSCs out of which 4,412 are complete.				
04	Firozabad	Number of total estimated HSCs is 36,000; out of which 17,820 are complete. One STP of 67 MLD capacity is under construction.			
05	Ghazipur	Require land for STP.			
06	Gorakhpur	39 kms of sewer pipeline has been laid, will take 3 months to start the work of providing HSC.			
07	Loni	Total 91,338 HSCs to be given, out of which 10,000 are complete.			
08	Mainpuri	Cleaning sewer lines stand as an issue; Lines connected with one STP of 23 MLD, Total 5,281 HSCs to be given.			
09	Meerut	Has an STP with a capacity of 72 MLD, Total 14,450 HSCs out of which 10,486 are complete. 28 Kms sewer pipeline has been laid but there is a gap of 70 meters and due to some legal issues it cannot be carried out. They are working on it and hope to resolve it soon.			
10	Muzaffarnagar	Total 4,700 HSCs in West Zone, all of them are complete. One STP in not functional from the past 1 year.			
11	Rampur	Sewer lines are choked in different places.

The SSU was directed to make a case about the work process being adopted by the CSOs, use ofhttp://aasaan.websiteportal and data representation on the consoles of the State Government, Missions, the Directorate and ULBs. Responding to demands; if any, it was clarified that special consoles may be created for UPJN to access specific feedback from the ground and initiate corrective measures; if any.
